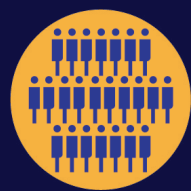

文凭课程

文科文凭 (DipArts)、商科文凭 (DipCom) 和理科文凭 (DipSci) 均属新西兰学历框架 (NZQF) 下的5级文凭学历, 专为那些仅没有达到大学入学要求的学生开设。

这些文凭课程让那些满怀抱负、几乎可以达到大学入学要求的学生能够获得学历，并在此后直接升读相关的学士学位课程，即文学学士（BA）、商科学士（BCom）和理学学士（BSc）的第二年。

每个文凭课程的学习时长均为一学年，与大学的常规学年（两个12周的学期加考试期）保持一致。文凭课程采用精心设计的课程结构，提供充满支持的学习环境，实行小班教学，并配套专门的学术和成长关怀服务。

文凭课程还在每一门课中融合了传统毛利智慧和太平洋地区视角，为学生们未来在新西兰的学业和就业提供了扎实的文化背景

文凭课程的设计理念是营造一个优秀的学习社区，于此学生能够在课程学年期间与同学们一起学习，并共同升读学士学位课程的第二年。

课程既包含大学预科科目（NZQF 5级课程科目），也包含学生所选择的学士学位第一年的科目（NZQF 7级课程科目）。学生将与本地学生共同学习。

奥塔哥大学预科证书是能够满足大学入学要求的学历，可于两个为期13周的学期内完成。该证书属于NZQF 4级学历。

预科证书课程是不符合大学入学要求、但仍希望获得大学学位的学生的理想预备课程。该课程让学生能够在充满支持与帮助的环境中实现升学目标。

预科证书课程由一系列精心设计、节奏适中的课程构成，为学生夯实学术知识和学习技能基础，并帮助他们树立信心，在大学取得成功。学生将与本地学生共同学习。

预科证书课程分为四个主要专业方向。每个方向的学习都能帮助你从预备课程向你选择的本科学位课程平稳过渡。

奥塔哥入学英语课程

奥塔哥入学英语课程（EFO）为那些已符合本科或研究生课程的学术入学要求、但尚未达到英语入学要求的学生提供了直升途径。





具体来说，如果学生的雅思成绩与奥塔哥大学的英语入学要求仅相差0.5分（或同等水平其他英语能力证明），那么这一为期12周的课程可以帮助学生达到入读本科或研究生级别课程的语言要求。

已获得奥塔哥大学本科或研究生课程的有条件录取通知书的学生有资格报读奥塔哥入学英语课程（EFO）课程。

本课程为强化课程，有较高的入学标准。学生必须参加入学考试才能入读奥塔哥入学英语课程（EFO）课程，或是在课程开始前的两年内达到入学要求的英语水平。

成功完成奥塔哥入学英语课程（EFO）课程后，学生无需重新参加雅思考试或其他语言能力测试，便可直接升入计划入读的大学课程。
