

Your Study Centre



Accommodation

UEL is one of the only London-based universities to have a self-contained campus. Additionally, our student accommodation is just steps away from the International Study Centre.*

Being based on-campus means that you have the ability to better manage your time, saving you money and ensuring you always feel secure. With comfortable student accommodation (preference given to international students), you will have peace of mind knowing that you are never far from your lectures, or the other university facilities.

Living on-campus in UEL accommodation means that there is a 24/7 security number for you to call should you have any problems or concerns.

The Accommodation at UEL is right on the dock front in bright modern buildings. All accommodation buildings have a social calendar should you wish to relax with others from your building which include cinema nights and celebrations for cultural occasions.

Accommodation options include Standard, Enhanced (Ensuite), Studio, and Premium Kitchen accommodation with pricing starting from as little as £3,200 for two terms of study.


