** The total cost of tuition for one academic year at Jacobs University excluding scholarships is € 20,000 for the following graduate programs: Data Engineering, Supply Chain Management, Data Science for Society & Business. The tuition fees for one academic year for the graduate program Psychologie is € 10,000.

- **TUITION** — for one academic year
- **UNIVERSITY FEE** — covers the student government fee, the graduation fees, etc.
- **SEMESTER TICKET** — allows students to travel on local public transportation at no additional cost for the entire year (including local trains to neighboring cities like Hannover, Hamburg, Osnabrück, and Oldenburg)
- **ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT** — in order to confirm your acceptance of our offer of admission, you must pay a one-time enrollment deposit of € 500. The enrollment deposit is a down payment on your first semester's fees.
- **ACCOMMODATION** — For our master students Jacobs University offers attractive accommodation off campus in the city of Bremen (room only). The fee for accommodation for one academic year (nine months) is € 4,000. Prospective graduate students may apply for accommodation when applying for the program of their choice.
- **RESIDENCE PERMIT** — required of all non-German students studying in Germany.
- **HEALTH INSURANCE – REQUIRED OF ALL STUDENTS!** — You may be able to find less expensive health insurance from home, but you need to make sure that the insurance will cover all applicable costs in Germany. You also need verification of your health insurance in order to enroll.
