



## 2024 INTERNATIONAL SUMMER ENGLISH PROGRAM

### **(1) Role of the Volunteer**

- Your primary role as a volunteer is to interact with the visiting international students to help enhance their experience here in Canada. They are here to learn English and to experience Canadian culture.
- Many of them are excited to meet Canadian students; therefore, it is very important that you engage with the students in the classroom, at recess and lunch and on the excursions. The hope is that you too will have a positive cultural experience with the students.

- Encourage English speaking by modeling this with the students inside and outside of the classroom.
- We expect all students, including volunteers, to participate in the activities.

### **(2) Volunteer Preparation**

- Make sure you are well-rested and nourished. The days will be busy and you will need your energy to keep up with the students!
- Please pack lunch and snacks for the day. Be sure to have water so that you stay hydrated.
- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the day.
- Sunglasses, hat, and sunscreen are strongly recommended as our outings/field trips are almost always **outside**.

12:30 – 1:45	English instruction in class (Volunteers to assist in assigned class)
1:45 – 2:00	RECESS (Volunteers to interact with students outside or in gym)
2:00 – 3:00	English instruction in class (Volunteers to assist in assigned class)
