



The faculty's AACSB, EQUIS and EFMD programme accreditations illustrate our high-quality teaching and research, placing us among a select group of global leaders in business education. UAntwerp is the only Flemish university that is mentioned in the Financial Times European Business Schools Ranking 2022, being ranked 92nd. The Master of Business Economics placed 87th in the FT Masters in Management Ranking 2023, and obtained an impressive 6th place worldwide in terms of value for money.

With this Double Degree programme, you get the opportunity to acquire two Master's degrees in business and economics in two years' time at two top-quality Belgian universities. You also benefit from different teaching styles, get the chance to do a full semester of internship and develop your leadership skills with professional coaches.

In short, a double degree is the ideal stepping stone, as employers favour graduates who are open-minded, used to working in multicultural teams and not afraid to face global challenges head on.

### Innovative business city

As a student in Antwerp, you find yourself in the only Belgian city that made it onto the **Financial Times's list of most innovative business cities in Europe**. In 2022, Antwerp was selected by the Financial Times as one of the top 10 growth cities in the world for economic potential. And for good reason. The city is home to Europe's second biggest port, the global diamond trade, a large chemical and oil cluster, thriving fashion industry, plenty of start-ups and incubators, and much more. Plus, you are only 45 minutes away from Brussels, the headquarters of the European Union and NATO. Because of its central location, you can easily travel from Antwerp to other European cities like Amsterdam, Paris or Berlin.



# **Programme structure**

Deciding to **study abroad** is an important decision. So if there is one thing we can guarantee, it's that you won't just be a number at the Faculty of Business and Economics. In addition to a thorough theoretical foundation, ample attention is paid to providing opportunities for applying the theory to specific cases or situations. For example, the course Ethical and Sustainable Business includes a business game, in Banking you take part in a banking game and in the course on Machine Learning, you participate in a data science challenge. Guest speakers and alumni are invited to share their practical-professional expertise. Many of our professors play important roles within companies, boards or international advisory organisations and bring business practice and policy advice closer to students.

### **Admission criteria**

If you have a **university level** Bachelor's degree in Business Economics, Master's degree in Business Administration or equivalent, you are eligible to start the programme. This degree should be an academic programme. You should have a thorough command of intermediate micro- and macro-economics, quantitative research methods, mathematics, statistics, financial and management accounting, finance, marketing and management.

A number of academic degrees obtained in Belgium or the Netherlands give direct access to the Master. Consult the website for a full overview:

Since the programme is taught in English, candidates with a prior degree issued outside Belgium, the Netherlands or Luxembourg are required to demonstrate their proficiency in English. They can do so:

By submitting a **language certificate** showing their TOEFL, IELTS or ITACE results (the level required can be checked on: <a href="www.uantwerpen.be/admission">www.uantwerpen.be/admission</a>). Students with prior degrees from the United Kingdom, Ireland, United States, Canada, Australia and New Zealand are exempt from providing a language certificate.

Please note that the Board of Admission may still ask for additional proof of proficiency in English.

A GMAT/GRE test result is to be included in the application. You should obtain an overall GMAT score of 600 + 49 on quantitative part or higher. Alternatively, a GRE can be submitted with a minimum score of 160 on quantitative reasoning + 152 on verbal reasoning.

Prof. Koen Vandenbempt, Dean Students are exempt from submitting a **GMAT/GRE** test result if they have obtained their (business) economics degree at one of the **following institutions**:

_	A Belgian university
	A university ranked in the global top 400 in the most recent edition of THE or QS World Ranking
	One of the faculty's exchange partners
	A university with an AACSB, EFMD or EQUIS accreditation

If you do not belong to the category above, but have an academic degree with a (limited) economic or management component, you might have the possibility to start the Master of Business Economics through a **preparatory programme**. Depending on the size of the assigned preparatory programme, you can combine this with your Master's programme. The Board of Admission will determine your eligibility and your individual preparatory programme based on your diploma(s).

Students who are still completing their Bachelor's degree are also encouraged to apply. Applicants that are enrolled in their final year should, instead of the degree, submit a copy of an original and signed letter from their college or university confirming that they are expected to complete the programme at the end of the current academic year.

# **Application procedure**

If you have a Bachelor's or Master's degree from a higher education institution in Belgium, the Netherlands or Luxembourg and you are not required to have a visa, you can apply via a simplified online form on our website. Candidates who do not fulfil this condition or who need a student visa must submit an online application through the **Mobility Online** tool. Applications for the academic year 2024-2025 can be started in Mobility Online as from 9 November 2023 onwards.

### **Application deadlines**

To submit an application through Mobility Online

For non-EEA \* nationals and for students who need a visa: **before 1 March 2024** 

For EEA nationals: before 1 June 2024

### **Enrolment deadline**

4 October 2024 Enrolments start on 1 July 2024.

The academic year 2024-2025 starts on Monday 23 September 2024.

### **ECTS** credits

The University of Antwerp applies the 'European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System' (ECTS) to all its degree programmes.

A full-time one-year study programme amounts to **60 ECTS credits** (30 ECTS credits per semester), which implies a student workload of about 1500 to 1800 hours. One ECTS credit stands for 25 to 30 hours of work including contact hours, preparatory work, study and assessment.
