Political decisions give direction to society. But how are political decisions made? The Master of Political Science provides you with specialist, in-depth knowledge of **decision-making in politics**. Besides the acquisition of theoretical and analytical insight, you will also practise core skills involved in political decision-making, such as **argumentation**, **negotiation** and **lobbying**.

In detail

The Master of Political Science aims to improve your understanding of political decision-making from **different perspectives**. In this programme we explore:

- How and why citizens participate in politics. Who participates and who does not?
- How elected **politicians** translate their political preferences into political action.
- What impact policy professionals such as political advisors, consultants or civil servants can have on policy decisions.
- How **institutions** constrain and enable the potential for political cooperation.

To understand political decision-making, you should be able to adopt these four (sometimes very different) perspectives. After all, elected politicians make binding decisions for society, but the participation of citizens is the bedrock of legitimate decision-making. In our Master's programme we train/develop experts who are able to understand, explain and influence outcomes of decision-making in a rapidly evolving political context.

An international profile

Do you have the ambition to work in an international context? An active command of English, including knowledge of international political jargon, is necessary. The entire Master's programme is taught in English and prepares you to access a professional environment in which English plays an increasingly important role.

The English programme also offers an international community where you come in contact with diverse, comparative perspectives on politics.



Programme structure

The Master of Political Science does not exclusively aim at the acquisition of theoretical and analytical insights. You will also practise some of the core skills involved in political decision-making, such as **argumentation**, **negotiation** and **lobbying**.

Besides the mandatory courses you can **tailor your programme to your personal interests**. The political science cluster has a variety of courses on issues in national and international politics. The interdisciplinary cluster allows you to broaden your view on politics.

The expertise you gain in this Master's programme culminates in the **Master's thesis**. A successful thesis demonstrates that you are able to explore a complex political subject independently in a scientific manner.

Orientation year

International students can choose to look for work opportunities in Belgium after completing their studies. You can apply for an orientation year and extend your stay in Belgium by 12 months. Guidance and administrative assistance with this process is available through the university.

Admission criteria

All information about the admission requirements and application procedure can be found on www.uantwerpen.be/admission.

An overview of the academic Bachelor's or Master's degrees from higher education institutions in Belgium, the Netherlands or Luxembourg, which give direct access to the Master of Political Science can be found on the programme's website www.uantwerpen.be/political-science-admission.

If you have a Bachelor's or Master's degree from a higher education institution outside Belgium, the Netherlands or Luxembourg, you need to submit an online application via Mobility Online, before you can enrol.

Important: In order to be admitted directly to the programme, a background in social science research methods is essential.

Admission with a preparatory or bridging programme


Students who do not meet the direct admission requirements can start a bridging programme or a preparatory programme, if approved by the Board of Admission. The preparatory and the bridging programme will help you develop any programme-specific knowledge and (research) skills that were not addressed in your prior studies. Once you have successfully completed the programme, you will receive a certificate that gives you permission to enrol in the Master of Political Science at the University of Antwerp.

Since the programme is taught in English, candidates with a prior degree issued outside Belgium, the Netherlands or Luxembourg are required to demonstrate their proficiency in English. They can do so in two ways:

Either by submitting a **language certificate** showing their TOEFL, IELTS or ITACE results (the level required can be checked on www.uantwerpen.be/admission)

Or by submitting **proof** they have studied at least one academic year (or 60 ECTS credits) in an Englishlanguage Bachelor's or Master's programme.

Please note that the Board of Admission may still ask for additional proof of proficiency in English.

Application procedure

Candidates with a Bachelor's or Master's degree from a higher education institution in Belgium, the Netherlands or Luxembourg can enrol directly into the programme, provided that they meet the specific admission requirements.

Candidates who have a Bachelor's or Master's degree of another country or who need a student visa must submit an online application through the **Mobility Online** tool.

Applications for the academic year 2024-2025 can be started in Mobility Online as from 9 November 2023 onwards.

Application deadlines

To submit an application through Mobility Online

For non-EEA * nationals and for students who need to apply for a visa: **before 1 March 2024**

For EEA nationals: before 1 June 2024

Enrolment deadline

4 October 2024 Enrolments start on 1 July 2024.


The academic year 2024-2025 starts on Monday 23 September 2024.

ECTS credits

The University of Antwerp applies the 'European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System' (ECTS) in all its degree programmes.

A full-time one-year study programme amounts to **60 ECTS credits** (about 30 ECTS credits per semester). One ECTS credit stands for 25 to 30 hours of work including contact hours, preparatory work, study and assessment.
